

Mapfre Foundation. Recoletos Exhibition Hall

The building that holds the exhibition halls of Mapfre Foundation was constructed between 1881 and 1884 by the architect Agustín Ortiz de Villajos, for the duchess of Medina de las Torres.

The building originally consisted of a height of four floors and semi-basement, but in 1910 two towers were built in the corners. After a series of refurbishment and restructuring projects, the building now has an exhibition area with an approximate surface of 1,000 m², divided into three halls.

This foundation organises painting, sculpture and drawing exhibitions with a focus on the period spanning from the last third of the 19th century to after World War II.

Mapfre Foundation has another exhibition hall in Madrid called [Sala Bárbara de Braganza](#). Located very close to Sala Recoletos, it is dedicated to the great masters of photography.
