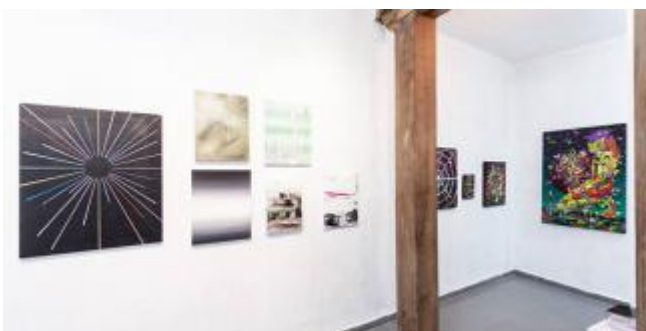


# Welcome to Madrid
