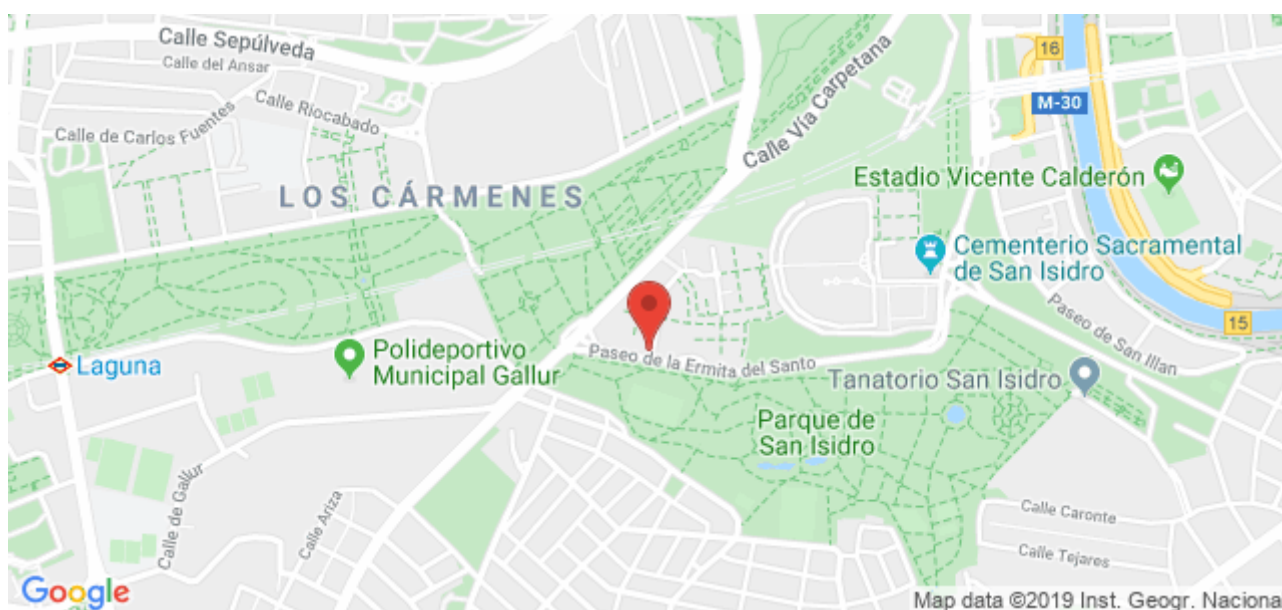


San Isidro Cemetery

Opened in 1811, it is the oldest cemetery in Madrid. It was built behind the Chapel of San Isidro Labrador in accordance with the project by José Llorente and, following various extensions and the final definition of its boundaries in 1980, it has a surface area of 120,000 m² divided into various patios in different styles. The large number of architectural and sculptural elements, as well as its landscape value, mean that it is known as *Historic Cemetery*.

The cemetery offers guided tours, and places must be booked in advance by writing to info@cementeriodesanisidro.com. They take place on Saturdays and Sundays at 11:30am, offering four different routes that will reveal the secrets of this cemetery, a holy place of exceptional cultural interest.
