In 1969, Durán Arte y Subastas was founded and national and international museums and private collectors have had major works of art and all types of collectors' items available to them for more than four decades.

As part of its philosophy of innovating and continuing to grow, it has created Durán Exquse, an accessible luxury brand with a Mediterranean spirit in silver with natural stones, in which design and attention to details prevail.

The fourth generation of the family is now working in this firm.
