- 27 June: Race for diversity
- 28 June: International LGBTI Day
- 29 June: Madrid Summit 2020
- 1 July: PRIDE OPENING CEREMONY: Marks the start of the Pride Celebrations in Plaza de Pedro Zerolo and 5 days of free outdoor concerts, shows, parties, art, culture and sport
- 2 July: HIGH-HEELED RACE
- 3 July: 13<sup>th</sup> EDITION OF MR. GAY PRIDE ESPAÑA
- 4 July: PRIDE PARADE: the main event of Pride, it goes through the city's main streets, from Atocha to Colón
- 5 July: MADO '19 CLOSING CEREMONY
