

Welcome to Madrid

Event postponed until 8 November

Madrid will once again host the final stage of the Vuelta a España cycling race (delayed till 20 October-8 November 2020 due to coronavirus) that celebrates its 85th anniversary in 2020 and the 75th edition. After 18 grueling days the Dutch legs of the race have been suspended, the cyclists will arrive in the Spanish capital for the last stage.

The final day, which will have a spectacular start at the La Zarzuela Hippodrome, will serve as a tribute to the bearer of the Red Jersey on its eleventh anniversary. It is a short route (125 km), in which the cycling will be slow but with a final stage for explosive sprinters who wish to savour the glory of a prestigious final like that of Madrid. Afterwards, there will be the classic podium in front of **Cibeles** and **Madrid City Council**.
