

Welcome to Madrid

This library, located in the Conde Duque Cultural Centre, was founded in 1919 at the suggestion of Víctor Espinós, conceived as a Mobile Musical Library. This centre was created for the dissemination and promotion of musical education, and from its inception it has aimed to provide a public service, open to all kinds of users.

The library offers an essential bibliographic collection specialised in music with monographs, scores, audiovisual teaching methods and audiovisual and sound registers in a wide variety of mediums (92,929 works), as well as an exceptional collection of musical instruments on loan (329).

It has different free services for the public: check out books, scores and audiovisuals, home loan of instruments, 16 music rehearsal booths (12 individual and 4 group, with 7 pianos, 1 double bass), 30 reading stations and an activity room.
