**Close to the famous Plaza Dos de Mayo you can find the Madrid's first ice-cream shop specialized in taiyaki, ice cream served in fish-shaped cones. It is originally from Japan, but these days you can find in big cities around the world, like New York.**

The small shop offers two types of ice-cream cones (vanilla and chocolate) that are then filled with soft ice-cream of your choice and finished off with different types of toppings ranging from brownies to toasted coconut or corn flakes. They also offer small fish-shaped taiyaki cakes filled with chocolate, peanut butter or apple pie and more traditional ice-cream cups and cones.
