***La Traviata*, the greatest work by Giuseppe Verdi, will be performed under a revamped production by the Amsterdam National Opera & Ballet, based on the Salzburg Festival production and directed by Willy Decker, from Germany. It is a show that will be performed in Italian with subtitles in Spanish and English at the Royal Theatre.**

The performance also has four casts which will be alternated, headed by artists of the likes of Nadine Sierra, Lisette Oropesa, Michael Fabiano and Ismael Jordi.

The story tells how the young Alfredo Germont falls in love with the courtesan, Violetta, one of the most famous in Paris, and they go to live together. However, Alfredo's father, Giorgio, does not approve of this relationship and begs his son to leave his beloved.

Having failed in his attempt, he turns to the woman to try and convince her of the damage that she is causing to his son. She confesses that her love is real, but her remorse leads her to abandon her sweetheart.

The show will be performed in Italian with Spanish and English subtitles.
