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
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# INTRODUCTION

It will soon have a terrace in the recently renovated Plaza de España, which has been pedestrianised.

Located on 289 Calle del Príncipe de Vergara, next to the Plaza de Perú, it takes its name from an eatery that used to occupy this same place until 2003: El Lince-Casa Avelino. The sign and the illuminated façade of the old establishment have been preserved, although the interior has been completely refurbished. The spirit of that traditional, honest and tasty cuisine has been maintained with a popular, less radical culinary offering, with dishes everyone can enjoy, where you can eat really well and try different dishes every week.





Sienna and green tones call to mind the towns of southern Italy, giving this second space a warmer, more serene ambience. A new urban landmark for both the district, as well as the neighbourhood, is planned and will come in the form of a large exterior square where people can gather. The space devoted to culture isn't just one single part of the building, instead, culture and science are intertwined throughout the building.

San Blas/Canillejas

The future City of Sport is to be located in the vicinity of the Civitas Metropolitano Stadium, in the San Blas–Canillejas district. The area of land—which was originally going to form part of the city’s application to host the Olympic Games—comprises five undeveloped plots to be used exclusively for sports purposes. The space will welcome various sports facilities, including football pitches, a mini stadium for 6,000 spectators, 25 padel courts, a climbing wall, a surfing area with teaching facilities, a skate and jump zone, an athletics track, and much more.



### SANTIAGO BERNABÉU STADIUM

At the end of 2022, the Santiago Bernabéu Stadium will show off its new look and unveil its new spaces. These will include a huge, unsupported cornice built over the square, forming a large entrance atrium spanning 2,000 m<sup>2</sup> to welcome visitors to the new Bernabéu. Refurbishment work includes the construction of a new stand on the east side of the stadium, which will be slightly higher than the current one but will have the same capacity. A retractable roof is also being installed, which will allow for the pitch to be used regardless of the weather and will help to reduce noise pollution for surrounding residents.

### CHINATOWN (USERA)

Together with the Municipal Council of Usera and the Tourism Department, Madrid City Council is working on a project to convert part of this district into the capital's new Chinatown, given the number of Usera residents that are of Chinese origin and the high number of visitors to the area, primarily drawn by the Chinese commerce, cuisine and culture on offer. The first steps will be to erect a sculpture of a panda donated by the Chinese community, and to build two grand gateways at the entrance and exit located at Plaza del Hidrógeno and where Calle del Olvido and Calle de Dolores Barranco meet. What's more, at the weekends the area will host additional cultural activities with a focus on promoting the gastronomy of the local restaurants, above all those serving Chinese fare.



### READING SPACE IN OESTE PARK




### MONTAÑA DE LOS GATOS (EL RETIRO PARK)

Madrid City Council will reopen this singular building in the Buen Retiro Gardens to citizens and visitors. The construction of this 19th-century gem—which has been closed to the general public for almost two decades due to unsafe infrastructure—was ordered by King Ferdinand VII of Spain. The Montaña de los Gatos, or “Cat Mountain”, which owes its name to its popularity among the wild cats that live in the park, fell into disuse and is a restricted area. The last exhibition held at the gallery was in 2002. Located next to one of the entrances to the park, it welcomes visitors with a small pond and waterfall and lush vegetation.
